Aglianico is a full-bodied red wine which is found almost exclusively in Southern Italy in the regions of Campania and Basilicata. Chapin Family Vineyards is pleased to present our estate grown Aglianico. This viarietal is known for firm tannis and higher acidity than most wine varietals. This deep garnet colored wine has aromas of blueberry, vanilla and lavender. The taste is smooth and lingering with flavors of boysenberry, spiced plum and a hint of smoke.

This pairs well with rich and robust meat dishes as well as hard and sharp cheeses, such as Taleggio or Pecorino from Italy of Manchego from Spain
