This wine is earthier than most reds, bold and bright, spicy, black
pepper, cedar, plums. Deep inky purple color and deep rich
plummy flavors with aromas of blackberry, chocolate, pepper and
spice. Some vanilla and coconut.

The silky texture, high tannins and acidity make it great for pairing with curries as well as rich meaty dishes. Roasted pork, beef burgers, aged gouda swiss cheese, fresh mozzarella, sautéed mushroom, eggplant, stuffed peppers
