

Syrah 2017 Estate

This wine blended aging in both French and American Oak for over 24 months. 2017 was another year of drought. The vines had not seen much rain in the past couple of years which leaves additional salt in the soil. Due to the stress from a lack of rain the vines produced a wine with a very velvety texture and pleasing long finish.

Flavors such as mocha, blueberry and vanilla can be experienced on the palate.

This wine pairs well with wild game and aged hard cheese such as gouda
